Remember, Early Voting happens in August and Election Day for local candidates is **Tuesday August 20th** and school starts August 12th.



From Jeff Siegel, Section II Board President:

Please make sure you check your email from our Management Company for new updates due to Florida Statutes and Section II updates. Further, requests by homeowners for information will only be available online (Vantica) through your portal that is provided by our management company.

On Tuesday July 16, 2024, the board had an HOA Board meeting to discuss the increase in our trash pickup service. At the this time, The board decided to front the money to all of the homeowners and pay the increase out of the HOA until the end of 2024. When the new budget is presented in October, it will reflect the trash pickup increase to \$2856 which is \$19.73 per month per homeowner requiring an increase of \$7.23 per month in HOA dues.

The new Florida Statutes pertaining to HOA's will require some changes to our Section II rules and regulations. The board is reviewing these and would like to invite you to join this effort. If you would like

to be on the committee for this, you can contact Jeff Siegel at jeff@sdaevents.com. We will begin this process at the beginning of August.



AUGUST 2024 - PCSO Safety Tips to Make The New School Year Great

Starting a new school year can be incredibly exciting, between beginning new classes and reuniting with old friends; however, it's essential to remember safety when caught up in all the fun! Incorporating safety into your back-to-school planning is necessary and can be easy with information from the Pasco Sheriff's Office.

As we start a new school year, more traffic will be on the roads and sidewalks. PSO reminds all drivers, pedestrians and cyclists to avoid distractions such as cellphones while traveling. Please reduce your speed when driving through school zones and follow all traffic laws. If you're walking to school, use crosswalks and look in all directions for traffic before crossing. If you ride a bicycle, skateboard, or scooter, remember to wear a helmet and always walk instead of riding across the street. It's important to be familiar with Florida's school bus laws. When a school bus's lights and signals are on, never pass it.

Maintaining a safe learning environment is a collective responsibility. Parents and guardians, PSO urges you to talk with your children about the serious consequences of making any fake threat, including those made as a joke. Students can help by reporting any unsafe behavior or suspicious incidents. PSO thoroughly investigates all reported threats. If you know a potential danger, please refrain from sharing it on social media. Instead, report any tips regarding threats by calling the Pasco Sheriff's Crime Tips Line at 1-800-706-2488 or online at PascoSheriff.com/Tips. Additionally, students can report suspicious activity or threats to a School Resource Officer or school official.

Returning to school is the perfect time to talk about safe, appropriate online behavior with your kids. It's crucial to monitor who your kids talk to online and know the apps they use. Consider downloading the same apps to understand how they work and explore parental controls. It's important for kids to be cautious about who they talk to online because not everyone is trustworthy. Open conversations about online dangers will give kids the information they need to stay safe.

PSO school-based members, such as School Resource Officers, School Crossing Guards, and Traffic Control Officers, are excited to welcome students back to school. Their dedication to ensuring the safety of our students and school staff goes beyond providing campus security. SROs also serve as mentors, coaches, and teachers, providing support to students and their communities. SCGs and TCOs guide students and families across busy streets in school zones and regulate traffic to prevent incidents.
