MAY TREASURERS CORNER

Greetings! May is here and around Millpond the weather is already heating up. There's still time to finish those Spring Projects. Your board is continually identifying, prioritizing and completing projects as quickly as we feel comfortable with.

Here is an update.

- Our committee that is refreshing our landscaping has completed phase one. They have approval to move onto
 - the next area. Presently they are in the planning stages for
 - that. Thank you to all those involved with that.
- Bush replacement project's main phase has been completed. 70 Bushes have been installed and presently we are monitoring them to make sure they are surviving the transplanting. If further attention is needed around our grounds, we will inform the community of it.
- Clubhouse roof had two emergency repairs completed on it. This could not wait until the next meeting as water was entering the building and causing further damage. We are assessing the

- interior damage and will reporting as necessary any repairs that will be required.

Of the known nests that we monitor, we had 33 eaglets hatch and 30 of those eaglets survived to fledge their nest. Bald Eagle breeding season runs from October 1st to May 15th each year in Florida.
